Weak high pressure over the region will keep our weather dry and pleasant through tomorrow along the Central Coast. Temperatures will be quite warm today again today with some areas possibly reaching 80 degrees. An upper level trough off shore is expected to move over our area Friday through early next week sending a few weather systems inland. Some precipitation is likely at times as these systems move inland but the bulk of any moisture should remain north of our area. It looks like drier weather will return next Tuesday through Friday as the storm track moves northward a bit.... Erik
