WEATHER SUMMARY & DISCUSSION

SUMMARY... Good Morning... A strong ridge of high pressure along the West Coast will bring us dry weather all week with warmer than average conditions. Temperatures this afternoon should be a little warmer today with sunshine breaking through the areas of fog earlier in the day. Temperatures tomorrow should be in the 80's to mid 90's as an off shore flow develops over Western Washington. Temperatures will gradually cool off late in the week and over the weekend as the ridge of high pressure starts to break down. An upper level trough is expected to move inland Sunday into early next week bringing cooler and unsettled weather.... Erik
